


PHANTASMAGORIA

Synopsis

Phantasmagoria will send chills down your spine; it is a sudden, mysterious breath of air, thaticy murmur from those that are no longer here but are reluctant to leave for good. It's a reminder to respect the existence of those that continue to be present within our lives, because life is what they lack and what they yearn for. Do you feel it? Don't turn around and maybe, just maybe, they will pass on by.

Put together by the writer Darío Vilas, *Phantasmagoria* is a collection of fifteen short stories, which individually provide a very personal vision of the figure of the ghost, an idea of what the idea of a ghost represents to each one of the authors who contributed to this book, and how they have decided to represent these phantasmagoric figures. See how tales of terror, tension and literary games that make this work a style exercise like no other. This is a sampling of the best offerings from Spanish fantasy genre writers.

Biography

Darío Vilas is a writer, an editor and a web content creator. He combines his work as editorial advisor with the administration of the website www.culturahache.com, and conducts reviews for OcioZero.com and caraB.net. In 2010 he won the Nosferatu Award with *Proud Father*. He has been a finalist for many literary prizes: science fiction fantasy *SciFiWorld*, *Red Circle*, etc. He has seen his writings published in several anthologies, including *Anthology Z*, *Monsters of Cinema*, *Plague or Pumpkins in the Attic*. His first novel, *Survivor's Instinct*, was a finalist in the category of Best Book of Fiction for the *SciFi World* awards. He has recently published his second novel, *Lantana, where the instinct is born*.


